Jackpot Classes: \$20.00 entry fee

Youth All Day Fee: \$65.00 plus cattle charge

Amateur All Day Fee: \$95.00 plus cattle charge

Cattle Classes: \$15.00 Cattle Charge per class plus entry fee.

Office Fee: \$5.00 per horse

Stalls: \$25.00 / night **Un-stalled Horses:** \$10.00 / day

All overnight horses must be stalled

Camper Hook-ups \$25.00/ night, \$45.00 /weekend

Returned Check Fee \$40.00

EMRHA Membership Fees: \$25 Family, \$15 Single, \$5 Youth

ARHA Membership Fees: \$40 Family, \$30 Individual, \$20 Youth,

\$10 Amateur Card, \$10 Youth Card

ARHA Registration Fee: \$15 per horse

Owners & Exhibitors must be ARHA members.

All entries (except classes #1, 5, 12 & 13) must be ARHA

registered. Any stock type quarter horse may be registered with ARHA. A copy of horses AQHA, APHA, ApHC, IBHA, ABRA, PHBA (stock/qtr), PtHA (stock) papers must accompany registration application. Membership & Registration may be obtained at show.

For Green class eligibility see Green Rules

REQUIRED AT ENTRY: Current Negative Coggins,

Copy of ARHA registration papers, current ARHA membership card, and ARHA youth & amateur cards.

Failure to present cards & registration papers will result in denial of entry.

Must be an EMRHA member for points to count towards EMRHA year-end awards.

All classes will be judged according to ARHA rules.

Versatility Show Award: One horse/one rider combination, Must enter: A) One (1) conformation class, B) Two (2) non-cattle performance classes and C) Two (2) cattle classes. All classes must be declared at the time of entry. Awarded in ARHA Open, Amateur and Youth divisions.

High Point Show Award: One horse/one rider combination. Awarded in ARHA Open, Amateur and Youth divisions.

Western Attire required for all classes: long sleeve shirt, hat and boots.

Horses should be shown as naturally as possible-**No banded manes, hoof polish or silver. Tack should be working tack!**
